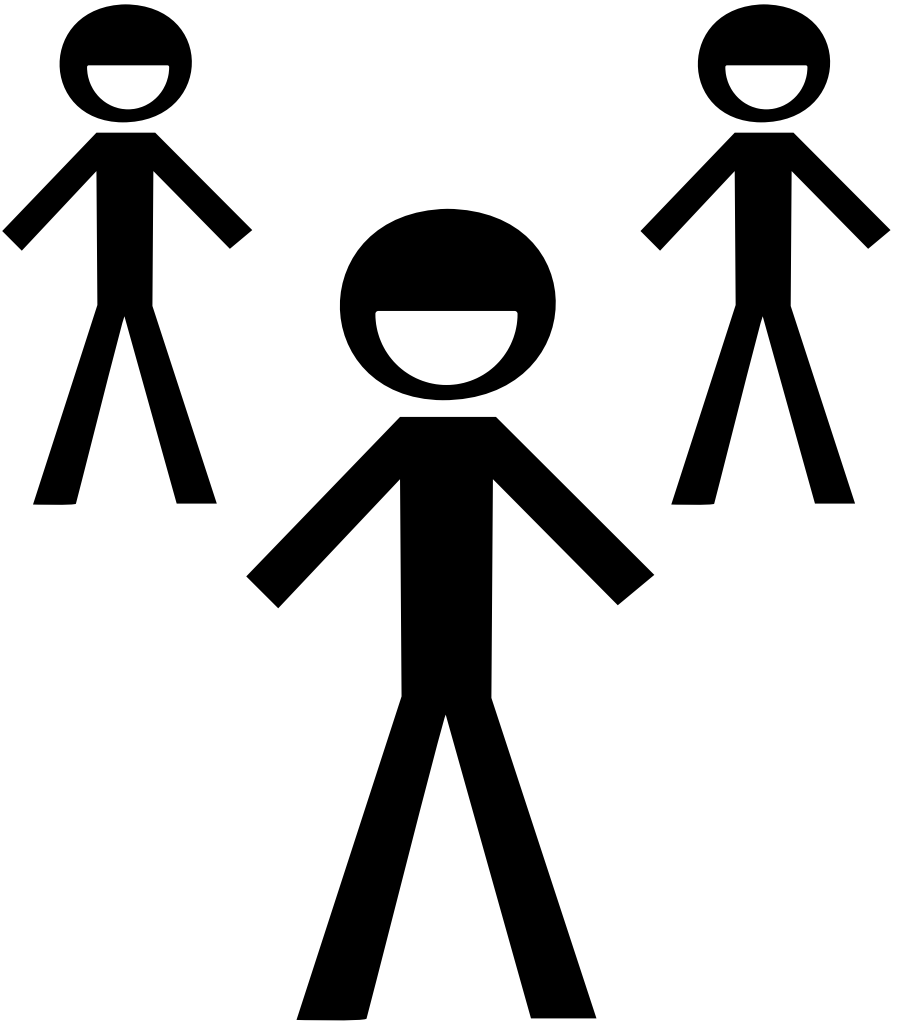


I will need a ticket to go to the concert.

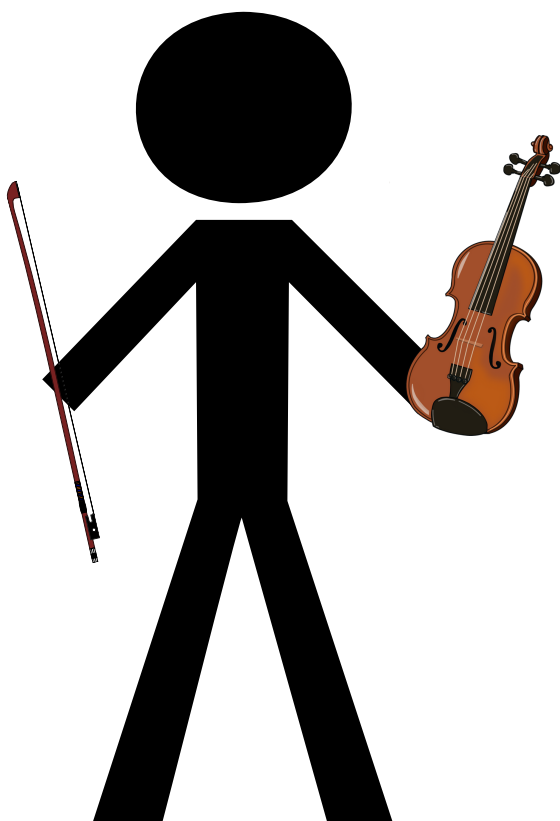
I can buy them online or at the box office.



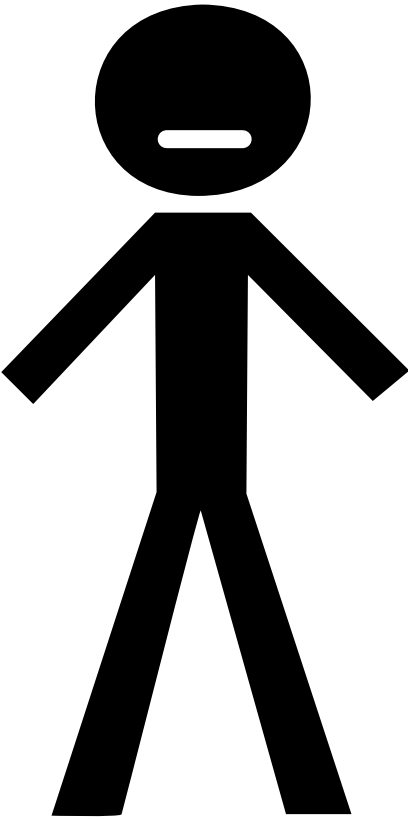
**There will be lots of

Petting Zoo'**

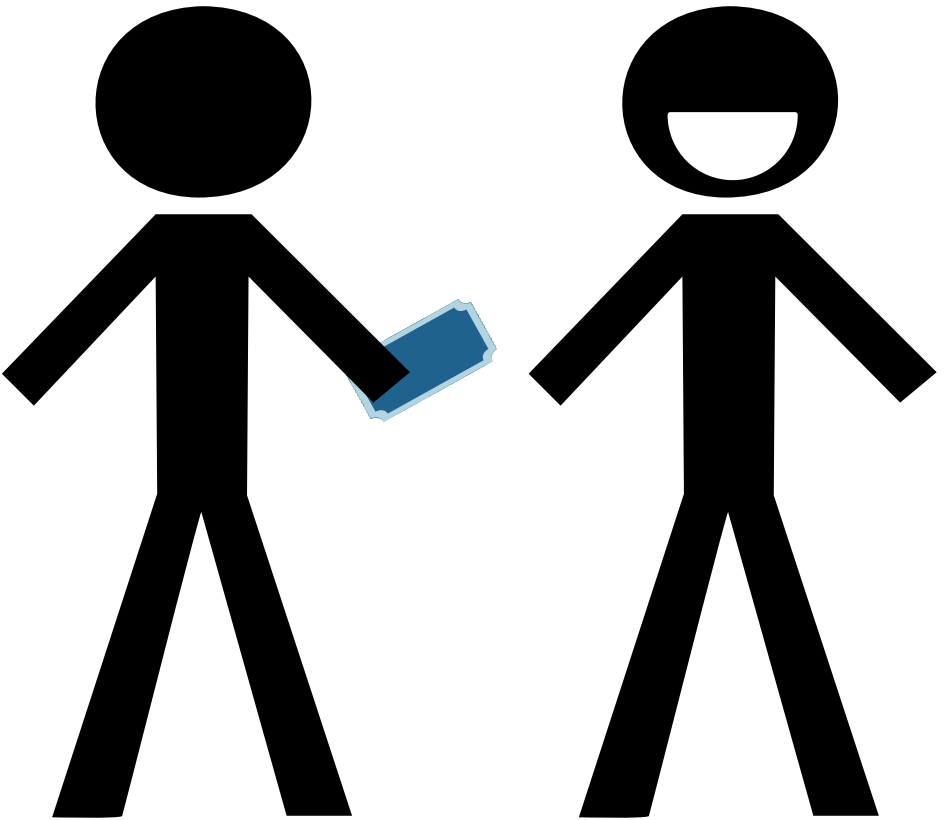


**When I need a break, I can go

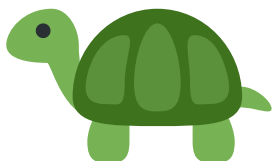

Presto (fast)

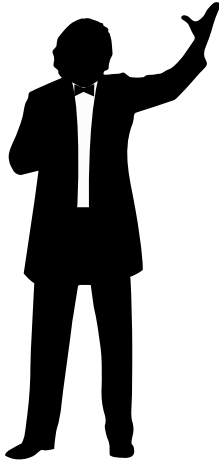


Forte (loud)



Piano (soft)

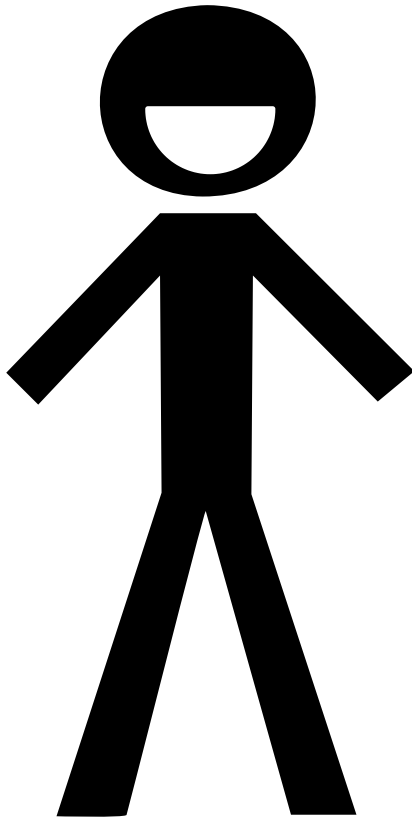
When the music ends, the conductor will put his arms down.
